The Regulations

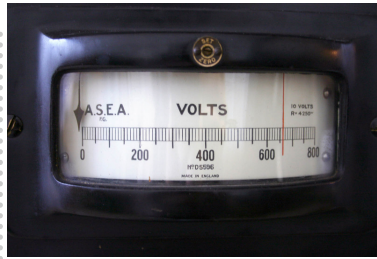
Under the Pressure System Safety Regulations 2000, the owner/operator of a system has a statutory obligation to prepare a written scheme for all pressure systems.

This is a document containing information about items of plant or equipment which form a pressure system, operate under pressure and contain the following type of fluid: compressed or liquefied gas, including air, at a pressure greater than 0.5 bar (approx. 7 psi) above atmospheric pressure.

The Audit

We can cover : -

- An assessment of those items of plant and equipment that need to be included on the written scheme.
- Preparation of a written scheme of examination.
- Listing preparations required to prepare equipment and plant for examination following the preparation of the written scheme.
- Certifying existing external scheme and/ or in-house scheme of examination.
- Review of the existing scheme of examination (where plant or equipment has changed or there has been a life cycle replacement).



The Report

The results are recorded in a full written report, with a summary of conclusions. We identify not only the components and systems that do not comply, but also quantify those that present the greatest risk.

We include a risk assessment to help you to prioritise hazardous areas.

Our digital photographs showing selected non-compliant items aid understanding of the problems.

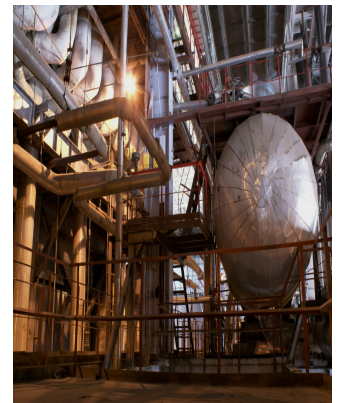
Our reports specifically list each item of plant and equipment within the scheme and detail any remedial work.

- Identification of plant or equipment
- Parts of the system to be examined
- Examinations, inspections and tests to be carried out
- Preparatory work required
- Examination needed before system is first used
- Maximum interval between examinations.
- Parts of system needing examination if modified or repaired
- Name of person certifying written scheme
- Date of Certification.
